The Edinburgh Society of Organists is able to claim a tax refund on any subscriptions and donations paid to the Society, where we hold a Gift Aid declaration signed by the donor. For a £12 annual subscription, this adds £3.36 each year to the Society's income, at no additional cost to yourself.

So long as you expect to pay at least £3.36 income tax or capital gains tax in the year, you are entitled to sign a Gift Aid declaration. We ask that you consider doing this - around 70% of ESO members have already done so

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
